## II. POSITION DESCRIPTIONS

POSITION TITLE	POSITION DESCRIPTION
<b>Adapted PE Aide</b>	Assist students enrolled in Adapted PE courses with their individual exercise program; to assist Adapted PE Instructors with set-up and clean-up for each course.
<b>Ambassador I, II</b>	Assist in outreach and recruiting efforts to local high schools and community-based organizations. Assist new and continuing College of Marin students with navigation.
<b>Assistant Coach, Athletics</b>	Assist head coach and athletes for athletic teams.
<b>Childcare Center Aide</b>	Assist classroom teachers with implementing child centered curriculum and maintenance of an optimal physical learning center.
<b>Choreographer</b>	Create choreography for drama productions; consult with director for shows.
<b>Concert Master / Orchestra Coach</b>	Work as an orchestra coach for the Performing Arts Department.
<b>Costume Designer</b>	Create, design and fabricate costumes for drama productions.
<b>Department Assistant I, II</b>	Assist in day-to-day tasks and operations of campus departments, under the direction of assigned academic or classified administrator.
<b>Driver</b>	Drive district or rental vehicles on designated trips.
<b>Front Desk Assistant Fitness Center</b>	Work at the front desk of the Fitness Center. Check guests in/out, clean machines, put away equipment, answer questions.
<b>Lab/Technical Assistant I, II</b>	Assist with the set-up and operation of labs or technical areas, including inventory.
<b>Lab Assistant, EMT</b>	Assist instructors with EMT lab practice classes.
<b>Lifeguard</b>	Provide certified lifeguard duties for summer swim or pool activities.
<b>Lifeguard Lead</b>	Lifeguard lead support to summer swim or pool activities. Assist with scheduling of lifeguards. Lead lifeguard in charge on the pool deck during swim hours.
<b>Lighting Designer</b>	Design and implement lighting for drama productions.
<b>Model</b>	Sit as a model for Fine Arts and Community Education Art courses.
<b>Musician</b>	Plays a musical instrument to support classroom activities.
<b>On-Site Event Coordinator, Athletics</b>	Assist the Athletic Director in assuring that all requirements for athletic events are met and that compliance rules are followed.
<b>Performing Arts Assistant</b>	Provide theater support to drama productions and student performances in Drama, Music and Dance.
<b>Police Officer Substitute</b>	Provide police services to the District Police Department.
<b>Set Designer</b>	Create set designs, provide sketches/models, plans and elevations for campus productions.
<b>Shuttle Bus Driver – Class B</b>	Drive district or rental busses on designated trips. Class B driver's license required plus California DMV employer pull.
<b>Tutor I, II</b>	Provide academic support to currently enrolled College of Marin students.
