POSITION TITLE	POSITION DESCRIPTION
Adapted PE Aide	Assist students enrolled in Adapted PE courses with their individual exercise program; to assist Adapted PE Instructors with set-up and clean-up for each course.
Ambassador I, II	Assist in outreach and recruiting efforts to local high schools and community-based organizations. Assist new and continuing College of Marin students with navigation.
Assistant Coach, Athletics	Assist head coach and athletes for athletic teams.
Childcare Center Aide	Assist classroom teachers with implementing child centered curriculum and maintenance of an optimal physical learning center.
Choreographer	Create choreography for drama productions; consult with director for shows.
Concert Master / Orchestra Coach	Work as an orchestra coach for the Performing Arts Department.
Costume Designer	Create, design and fabricate costumes for drama productions.
Department Assistant I, II	Assist in day-to-day tasks and operations of campus departments, under the direction of assigned academic or classified administrator.
Driver	Drive district or rental vehicles on designated trips.
Front Desk Assistant Fitness Center	Work at the front desk of the Fitness Center. Check guests in/out, clean machines, put away equipment, answer questions.
Faculty Diversity Internship Program Intern	Under direction of assigned supervisor, assist with department tasks and learning activities associated with degree or credential requirements.
Lab/Technical Assistant I, II	Assist with the set-up and operation of labs or technical areas, including inventory.
Lab Assistant, EMT	Assist instructors with EMT lab practice classes.
Lifeguard	Provide certified lifeguard duties for summer swim or pool activities.
Lifeguard Lead	Lifeguard lead support to summer swim or pool activities. Assist with scheduling of lifeguards. Lead lifeguard in charge on the pool deck during swim hours.
Lighting Designer	Design and implement lighting for drama productions.
Model	Sit as a model for Fine Arts and Community Education Art courses.
Musician	Plays a musical instrument to support classroom activities.
On-Site Event Coordinator, Athletics	Assist the Athletic Director in assuring that all requirements for athletic events are met and that compliance rules are followed.
Performing Arts Assistant	Provide theater support to drama productions and student performances in Drama, Music and Dance.
Police Officer Substitute	Provide police services to the District Police Department.
Set Designer	Create set designs, provide sketches/models, plans and elevations for campus productions.
Shuttle Bus Driver – Class B	Drive district or rental busses on designated trips. Minimum qualifications: CDL Class B driver's license with 25-Passenger and Air Brakes endorsement required plus California DMV employer pull. 1+ year experience operating a bus or similar vehicle.
Tutor I, II	Provide academic support to currently enrolled College of Marin students.
