Ambassador I, II	Assist in outreach and recruiting efforts to local high schools and community-based organizations. Assist new and continuing College of Marin students with navigation.	
Childcare Center Assistant I, II	Provide assistance to classroom teachers in the Child Development Center and Early Education Program.	
Department Assistant I, II	Assist in day-to-day tasks and operations of campus departments. Tasks will vary based on department function and need.	
Driver	Drive district or rental vehicles on designated trips.	
Lab/Technical Assistant I, II	Assist with the set-up and operation of labs or technical areas, including inventory.	
Peer Mentor I, II	Assist in the delivery of specific outreach programs and services on-campus and to local high schools.	
Police Cadet	Provide general assistance in the Campus Police Department to students, staff and visitors. Giving directions and assistance; parking enforcement; unlocking/locking doors; traffic control.	
Performing Arts Assistant	Provide theater support to drama productions and student performances in Drama, Music and Dance.	
Tutor I, II	Provide academic support to currently enrolled College of Marin students.
